



Located in Eguisheim, the cradle of Alsatian winemaking, Paul Zinck has established a special place in this region. This father and son duo have found, in essence, a balance in winemaking, between traditional craftsmanship and the contributions of new techniques. Since its founding in 1964, the winery has continually improved and modernized its equipment as well as the quality of its output, all the while remaining firmly committed to the values of a family business. Today, Paul Zinck produces quality wines whose character is enhanced by the pure vinification processes. In 2002 a new line of grand crus made its first appearance in a catalogue already rich with its other ranges of wines. The young and dynamic winemaker, Philippe Zinck, has developed a modern approach to his family estate, using grapes selected from the best limestone vineyards around the town of Eguisheim, to give pure varietal character.

Pinot Blanc

Grapes selected from the best limestone vineyards of Eguisheim to give pure varietal character. This easy drinking Pinot Blanc has fresh apple and mineral flavours with good weight yet it is soft and supple on the palate

Riesling

The Paul Zinck Riesling is dry, distinguished, delicately grapey. It has an elegant bouquet with floral and mineral notes. A gastronomic wine par excellence, it is an unrivalled accompaniment to fish, shellfish, seafood and white meats.



Pinot Gris

The Paul Zinck Pinot Gris develops a characteristically opulent flavour. Round, rich, and with a long finish, it has a complex and slightly smoky aroma. It is excellent with foie gras, game, white meats, and roasts.



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
