



The story of the Baroncini winery began in 1489, nestled among the gentle hills and winding roads of San Gimignano with Antonio di Bastiano. Enveloped by the bucolic splendor of this historic area of Tuscany, the production of Vernaccia wine was started. As was customary in Italy, Signore di Bastiano left this land to his daughter, Apollonia, who successfully followed in his footsteps. She devotedly pursued her father's passion, creating the Torre Terza farm, as it is still known today. Many centuries have gone by, and today the Baroncini children, Bruna and Stefano, still produce wine in San Gimignano, respecting the time honored traditions passed on to them through generations producing traditional wines and respecting the best vine-growing and wine-producing methods set forth by their ancestors over 500 years ago.

A family seated in the viticultural history of San Gimignano since 1489, Baroncini has grown beyond the boundaries of San Gimignano into all important regions of Tuscany, including Scansano, Montepulciano, and Montalcino. Together these vineyards encompass over 250 acres of premium vineyard sites and provide for the production of more than 1 million bottles of wine.
