



Podere la Vigna lies 7 kilometers to the north-east of Montalcino where many generations of the Rubegni family have farmed and eventually bought this estate in 1958. Today, Adriano Rubegni and his wife handle all aspects of the operation from vineyard management and winemaking to marketing. When the family bought the property the vines were trained up the trunks of Mulberry trees but, beginning in 1973, the best sites were replanted with quality oriented clones and trellises laid out for the best exposure to the sun and cool nighttime breezes. The Rosso is made in a quite forward style for early consumption but with a big mouthfeel, the Brunello is lush, rich and smoky with red fruit and herbal perfume and a firm, full and intense finish boding well for the future., and the Riserva is simply sublime!!!!

PODERE LA VIGNA Rosso di Montalcino

Good medium red. Pure, fruit-driven aromas of red cherry and ripe plum are complicated by intriguing notes of anchovy and bay leaf. Nicely delineated and sweet, with a strong red cherry and plum jam quality dominating on the palate. A medium-bodied, smooth and fleshy Rosso with a straightforward charm. Little-known Adriano Rubegni has quietly been making very good wines since 1996, his first vintage.

PODERE LA VIGNA Brunello di Montalcino

Loads of new, toasty wood on the nose, with intensely ripe fruit as well. Full body, very chewy and slightly austere from the new wood. But this will come around beautifully with bottle age.

PODERE LA VIGNA Brunello di Montalcino Riserva

Loads of milk chocolate, with ripe plums and blueberries. Full body, with chewy tannins and a powerful rich finish. This is so rich and opulent. So much going on. Superb. This cantina keeps getting better and better.



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
