il Ritratto di un vino nasce dalla terra

On the Italian border with Austria, the province of Trentino-Alto Adige has made a name for itself with its superb and distinctive varietal wines. Frequently acclaimed by both the Gambero Rosso and Decanter.

Ritratti wines are produced by La Vis, which stands at the centre of an area boasting a century-old vine-growing tradition, back in the times when the Rhetians, a proud and enterprising people, started producing their quality wine. The name of the town of LaVis derives from the Avisio stream which is one of the most significant features of this area. The strength of the Avisio is summarised in the latin word "vis", which means strength.

The Cantina La-vis E Valle Di Cembra winery is located in Trentino Alto Adige in the township of LaVis, near Trento. The production area consists of vineyards in Valle Dell'adige, extending up to the hills of Lavis, Sorni And Meano and to the typical terraces of Valle di Cembra. It also includes the South Tyrol areas of Pochi and Salorno, Isera in Vallagarina, and other areas in the province of Verona.

The Ritratti wines are obtained from vineyards growing in the most propitious locations and fully express the la-vis production philosophy. The labels are decorated with the lovely paintings by Giovanni Segantini, the famous Trentino painter who in his art expresses a close bond with nature and this land.



PINOT GRIGIO

Cantina La-Vis Pinot Grigio is a crisp and classic Northern Italian interpretation of this popular varietal. From the glass, the wine sports a lovely golden-straw color and juicy melon and Acacia flower aromas. Crisp and mouthwatering, the Pinot Grigio continues on the palate with notes of minerals, Meyer lemons, yellow plums and honey with a crisp and clean finish.

PINOT NERO

A lively ruby red color reminiscent of ripe cherries. Primary aromas of fresh woodland fruits are strongly evident on the nose, supported by the more complex aromas arising from the wood ageing process, creating a full and intense bouquet. On the palate, the slightly tannic flavor of sour, wild cherries underlines the wine's purity.
