### **Fat Of The Land 'Greenock' 2012**

An enigmatic expression of Barossa Shiraz, its mouth filling, fruit laden mid palate is enhanced by complex flavours of earth, wet stone and hints of leather and spice. This wine has been matured in 40% new French oak hogsheads for 20 months to further enhance its inherent structure. A textural wine to be savoured now, or in 10 to 15 years time. Supple and plush, with graceful tannins and ripe, succulent flavors of cherry and cassis. Accents of dried violet, sandalwood and cigar box linger on the long finish. Drink now through 2030.

### **Fat Of The Land 'Seppeltsfield' 2012**

A muscular brooding expression of Barossa Shiraz, it's flavour packed with kirsch, dark chocolate and liquorice. This wine has been matured in 40% new French oak hogsheads for 20 months to further enhance its inherent structure. Built for aging not for speed, have another look at this sleeper in 10 to 15 years time.

Bold, with toffee and nutmeg overtones to the core of dark, ripe plum and black cherry flavors. Finishes with a mouthful of thick, velvety tannins and lingering spice details. Drink now through 2029.—

### **Fat Of The Land 'Ebenezer' 2012**

A soft textured expression of Shiraz from the slurp factory of the Barossa. Brimming with luscious dark berry fruits, this wine has been matured in 40% new French oak hogsheads for 20 months sur lie to further enhance its texture. A wine for hedonists, so enjoy it now, or in 10 to 15 years time if you have a puritanical streak.

Supple and generous, with toasted rye and sarsaparilla accents to the plush plum and licorice flavors. Expressive and polished, this shows plenty of follow-through on the powerful finish. Drink now through 2024.
